The 4x4Games are definitely a unique experience and fun. Drivers and navigators will be tackling some interesting challenges. These games can include: 'Balance beam', 'Roll to the Line', 'Blind Dog Run', 'Spear the Ring', 'Ball and Post' and 'Nudge the Jug'. Only 4WDs may enter the 4x4Games and they will run continuously throughout the day starting at 10 AM.
